### Highlight

- The name of the book

- The specific verses you are going to journal on
- A title to describe the passage

### Explain

- Why was this written?
- To whom was it originally written?
- How does it fit with the verses before and after it?
- What was He intending to communicate through this text?

### Apply

- How can this help me?
- What does this mean today?
- What would the application of this verse look like in my life?
- What is God saying to me?

### Respond

- Write an action step that the Lord is leading to take in response to the passage OR
- Write a prayer to the Lord in response to this text
